[Proverbs 28:13](#) He that covereth his sins shall not prosper: but whoso confesseth and forsaketh *them* shall have mercy.

[Isaiah 1:18](#) Come now, and let us reason together, saith the LORD: though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool.

[Isaiah 43:25](#) I, *even I, am* he that blotteth out thy transgressions for mine own sake, and will not remember thy sins.

[Ezekiel 36:25-28](#) **25** Then will I sprinkle clean water upon you, and ye shall be clean: from all your filthiness, and from all your idols, will I cleanse you. **26** A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you an heart of flesh. **27** And I will put my spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes, and ye shall keep my judgments, and do *them*. **28** And ye shall dwell in the land that I gave to your fathers; and ye shall be my people, and I will be your God.

[Joel 2:12-13](#) **12** Therefore also now, saith the LORD, turn ye *even* to me with all your heart, and with fasting, and with weeping, and with mourning: **13** And rend your heart, and not your garments, and turn unto the LORD your God: for he *is* gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and repenteth him of the evil.

[Micah 7:18-19](#) **18** Who *is* a God like unto thee, that pardoneth iniquity, and passeth by the transgression of the remnant of his heritage? he retaineth not his anger for ever, because he delighteth *in* mercy. **19** He will turn again, he will have compassion upon us; he will subdue our iniquities; and thou wilt cast all their sins into the depths of the sea.

[Romans 3:22-24](#) [22](#) Even the righteousness of God *which is* by faith of Jesus Christ unto all and upon all them that believe: for there is no difference: [23](#) For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God; [24](#) Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus:

[Romans 3:25-26](#) [25](#) Whom God hath set forth *to be* a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God; [26](#) To declare, *I say*, at this time his righteousness: that he might be just, and the justifier of him which believeth in Jesus.

[Romans 4:4-8](#) [4](#) Now to him that worketh is the reward not reckoned of grace, but of debt. [5](#) But to him that worketh not, but believeth on him that justifieth the ungodly, his faith is counted for righteousness. [6](#) Even as David also describeth the blessedness of the man, unto whom God imputeth righteousness without works, [7](#) *Saying*, Blessed are they whose iniquities are forgiven, and whose sins are covered. [8](#) Blessed is the man to whom the Lord will not impute sin.

[Romans 5:1-2](#) [1](#) Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ: [2](#) By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

[Romans 5:8-9](#) [8](#) But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. [9](#) Much more then, being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him.

[Romans 5:20-21](#) [20](#) Moreover the law entered, that the offence might abound. But where sin abounded, grace did much more abound: [21](#) That as sin hath reigned unto death, even so might grace reign through righteousness unto eternal life by Jesus Christ our Lord.

[Romans 7:24-25](#) [24](#) O wretched man that I am! who shall deliver me from the body of this death? [25](#) I thank God through Jesus Christ our Lord. So then with the mind I myself serve the law of God; but with the flesh the law of sin.

[Romans 8:1-2](#) [1](#) *There is* therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit. [2](#) For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.

[Romans 8:33-34](#) [33](#) Who shall lay any thing to the charge of God's elect? *It is* God that justifieth. [34](#) *Who is* he that condemneth? *It is* Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God, who also maketh intercession for us.

[1:30](#) But of him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption:

[1 Corinthians](#)
[6:11](#) And such were some of you: but ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God.

[Ephesians 1:7](#) In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace;

[Ephesians 2:4-5](#) [4](#) But God, who is rich in mercy, for his great love wherewith he loved us, [5](#) Even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;)

[Ephesians 2:8-9](#) [8](#) For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: *it is* the gift of God: [9](#) Not of works, lest any man should boast.

[Ephesians 2:13](#) But now in Christ Jesus ye who sometimes were far off are made nigh by the blood of Christ.

[Colossians 1:13-](#) [13](#) Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath [14](#) translated *us* into the kingdom of his dear Son: [14](#) In whom we have redemption through his blood, *even* the forgiveness of sins:

[Colossians 2:13-](#) [13](#) And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of [14](#) your flesh, hath he quickened together with him, having forgiven you all trespasses; [14](#) Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross;

[1 Timothy 1:15](#) This *is* a faithful saying, and worthy of all acceptation, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners; of whom I am chief.

[Titus 3:4-5](#) [4](#) But after that the kindness and love of God our Saviour toward man appeared, [5](#) Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost;

[Hebrews 7:25](#) Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them.

[Hebrews 8:10-12](#) [10](#) For this *is* the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, saith the Lord; I will put my laws into their mind, and write them in their hearts: and I will be to them a God, and they shall be to me a people: [11](#) And they shall not teach every man his neighbour, and every man his brother, saying, Know the Lord: for all shall know me, from the least to the greatest. [12](#) For I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and their iniquities will I remember no more.

[Hebrews 9:11-12](#) [11](#) But Christ being come an high priest of good things to come, by a greater and more perfect tabernacle, not made with hands, that is to say, not of this building; [12](#) Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by his own blood he entered in once into the holy place, having obtained eternal redemption *for us*.

[Hebrews 10:12-](#) [12](#) But this man, after he had offered one sacrifice for sins for ever, sat down on the right hand of God; [13](#) From henceforth expecting till his enemies be made his footstool. [14](#) For by one offering he hath perfected for ever them that are sanctified.

[Hebrews 10:19-](#) [19](#) Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by the blood of Jesus, [20](#) By a new and living way, which he hath consecrated for us, through the veil, that is to say, his flesh; [21](#) And *having* an high priest over the house of God; [22](#) Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water. [23](#) Let us hold fast the profession of *our* faith without wavering; (for he *is* faithful that promised;)

[James 4:7-10](#) [7](#) Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. [8](#) Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you. Cleanse *your* hands, *ye* sinners; and purify *your* hearts, *ye* double minded. [9](#) Be afflicted, and mourn, and weep: let your laughter be turned to mourning, and *your* joy to heaviness. [10](#) Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and he shall lift you up.

[1 Peter 2:24-25](#) [24](#) Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed. [25](#) For ye were as sheep going astray; but are now returned unto the Shepherd and Bishop of your souls.

[1 John 1:7](#) But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.

[1 John 1:9](#) If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

[1 John 2:1-2](#) [1](#) My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous: [2](#) And he is the propitiation for our sins: and not for ours only, but also for *the sins of* the whole world.

[1 John 2:12](#) I write unto you, little children, because your sins are forgiven you for his name's sake.

[1 John 4:10](#) Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us, and sent his Son *to be* the propitiation for our sins.

[Revelation 1:5-6](#) **5** And from Jesus Christ, *who is* the faithful witness, *and* the first begotten of the dead, and the prince of the kings of the earth. Unto him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood, **6** And hath made us kings and priests unto God and his Father; to him *be* glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen.
