

Trinitarian Praise

These biblical confessions of praise may be used in personal devotionals or in a worship service. In corporate worship, they may be spoken to the Lord, as the congregation prays them together (in unison). They may be used responsively, with the minister leading one part and the congregation alternately praying the next part. These may even be used by a speech choir which leads the congregation in praying the various parts of praise.

1 — The Trinity and Adoption

Behold what manner of love the Father has bestowed on us,
that we should be called children of God! [1 John 3:1]
And we may call You “Abba, Father” [Romans 8:15]

Jesus, You are the Son of God
Whom the Father sent to redeem us
That we might receive the adoption as sons. [Galatians 4:4]

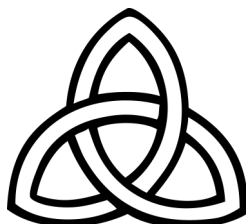
Indwelling Holy Spirit,
You are the Spirit of adoption, [Romans 8:15]
Who assures our spirits that we are sons of God [Romans 8:16]

2 — The Trinity and Comfort

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ,
the Father of mercies and God of all comfort,
who comforts us in all our affliction [2 Corinthians 1:3]

Our consolation abounds through Christ [2 Corinthians 1:5]
You’ve given us Your peace, not the peace the world gives
That we might not let our hearts be troubled, nor afraid. [John 14:27]

Holy Spirit, we walk in Your comfort [Act 9:31]
The Kingdom is righteousness, peace and joy in You [Romans 14:17]
And by Your power, we abound in hope. [Romans 15:13]

3 — The Trinity in Holiness

Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of hosts;
The whole earth is full of His glory! [Isaiah 6:3]
You are light and in You is no darkness at all. [1 John 1:5]

The Spirit of truth [John 14:26]

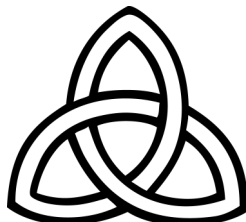
Who is like you, O Lord, among the gods?

And were made alive together with You.

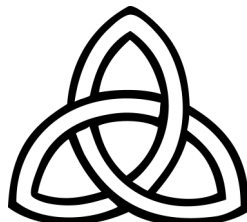

and made us a kingdom and priests to Your Father

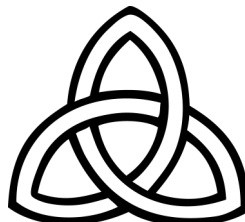
